Local Community Food Banks

The Nottawasaga Foundation has made local food banks one of the prime recipients of funding every year. The Good Shepherd Food Bank in Alliston assists over 300 families, Our Town Food Bank in Tottenham aids close to 100 families and the Angus Food Bank serves over 400 families.

Since 2001, the Foundation has donated over \$100,000.00 to the three food banks. These funds are used to provide food to those in need, especially during the Thanksgiving and Easter seasons.

Children's Aid Foundation of South Simcoe

Once again, the Nottawasaga Foundation was happy to provide funding for the Children's Aid Foundation of South Simcoe's Summer Sports Camp Program. For the near future, we are committed to implementing a high quality and innovative Urology Program at Stevenson and we are thrilled to have the commitment from the Nottawasaga Foundation to support this initiative.
